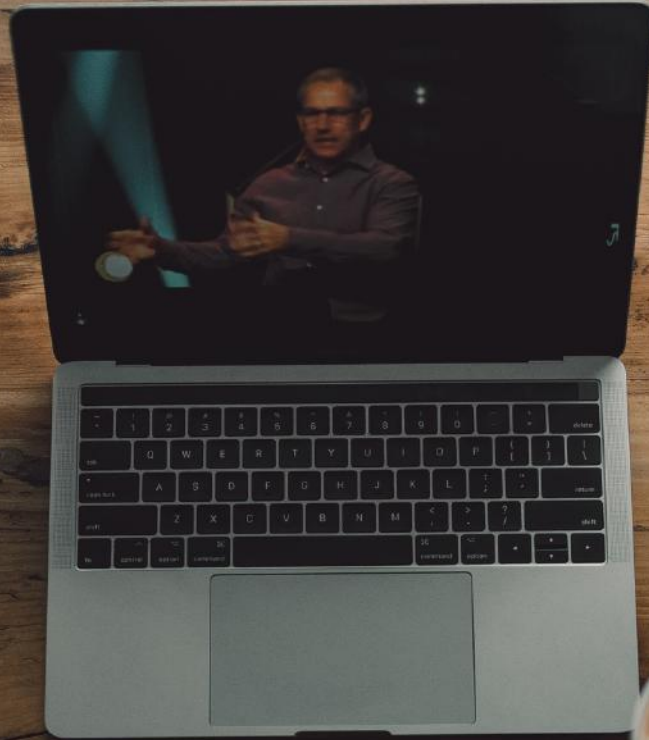

INTRODUCTORY TRAINING

To participate in the Introductory Training, you need to gather a learning group of at least four participants who have a strong interest in multiplicative urban disciple-making. You should also be prepared for action-oriented learning with practical tasks to complete.

- gain a Biblical and practical understanding of God Movements
- understand the complexities of cities
- form a pioneer team to engage the city
- help team members to identify and engage an affinity
- begin to multiply disciples and disciple-makers

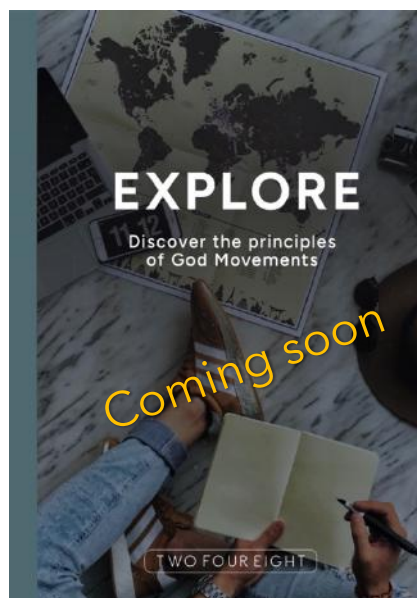
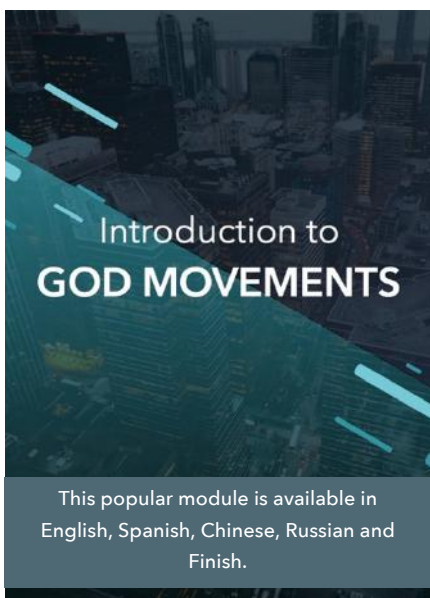
PARTICIPANT COMMITMENT

The six-week Training courses are designed for normal working people with limited time. Each participant is required to commit 20 minutes daily for five days a week to personal learning. There is an additional weekly 60 minute debrief for all participants.

PIONEER TEAM JOURNEY

To embark on the Pioneer Team Journey, you need to complete 'Introduction to God Movements' and have a team of Disciple-makers in formation.

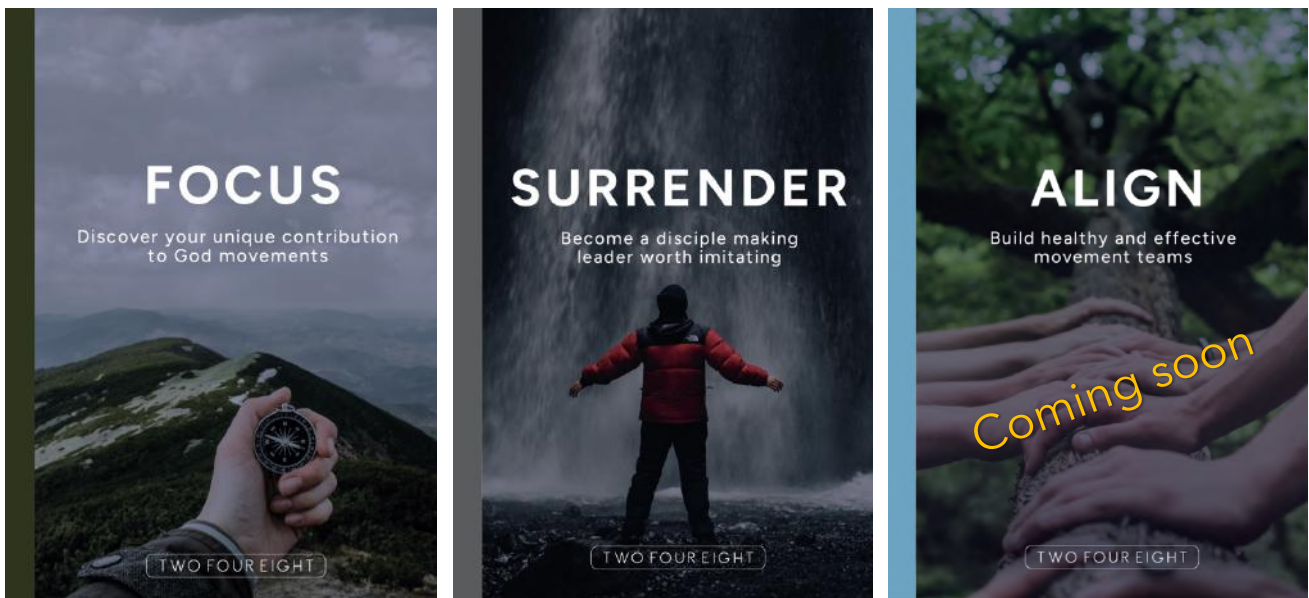
THE PIONEER TEAM JOURNEY WILL HELP YOUR TEAM TO...

- build a team with a strong shared mission and vision
- discover the unique calling, passions, interests, and abilities of each member
- remove obstacles to team effectiveness
- integrate faith, spiritual growth, and mission with everyday life
- clarify team expectations, purpose, outcomes, and shared rhythms

ENROLMENT PROCESS

A pre-training interview with the team leader is required. The team leader will be asked to sign a Two Four Eight Honour Agreement. This explains the terms of training that honours all parties involved.

MOVEMENT ACCELERATION COACHING (MAC)

Movement to Acceleration Coaching is a 3-to-5-year engagement with a Catalyst and team.

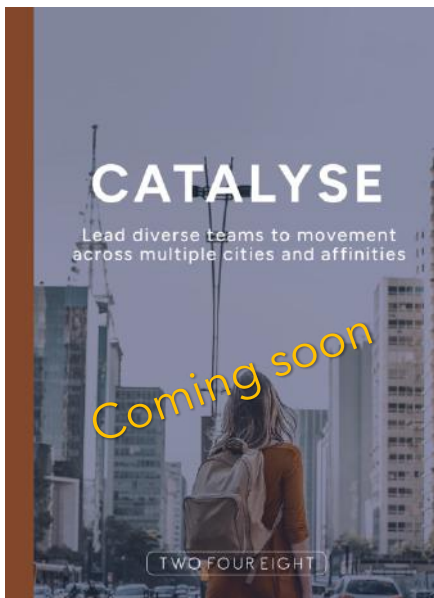
MOVEMENT ACCELERATION COACHING WILL HELP YOU TO...

- lead catalytic teams to movement across a city or Affinity network
- develop a city or network strategy through complexity mapping
- find movement Champions and mobilize them into multiplying disciples
- develop economic sustainability and resilience for the work
- move towards apostolic expansion by replicating new teams

ENROLMENT PROCESS

This journey requires a high commitment from both trainee Catalytic leaders, as well as Two Four Eight. Initial traction and a proven commitment to urban movements is required. The coaching relationship is by invitation only.

TOOLS AVAILABLE



QUEST

Quest is our first tool and is focused on leading Young Adults (aged 18-35) on a journey to discover their purpose and unique contribution while also introducing them to the concept of God. The central message of Quest is that God is good and cares deeply about our lives.

Our goal is to provide leaders with resources that will help them engage young adults in their spiritual journey of discovering God. These resources include...

Our goal is to continuously expand our understanding and enhance our approach by drawing insights from a broad spectrum of contexts and experiences.

OBSERVATIONS IN URBAN DISCIPLE MAKING MOVEMENTS

The 'Movements Insights' Research Project has developed from several hundreds of hours of interviews with movement leaders on the ground. Data gleaned from this process has been compiled in a document that outlines the 15 best practices observed in urban movements globally.

This project will continue to be updated. Learning and insights are used to adapt our training and coaching to best current practices.



Networks

PEER LEARNING NETWORKS

Global City Catalyst Network

Movement leaders from around the globe meet regularly online to learn best practices, ask questions, strategize, and chart a way forward for their specific city. This environment is highly interactive and encourages peer learning.

Next Gen Network

Practitioners and leaders engaged in discipling Young Adult (aged 18-35) are represented from various urban centres and affinities. They desire to see Disciple-Making Movements emerge amongst this age group.

Urban Slums Network

Disciple-Making leaders and practitioners focused on igniting movements in urban slums and township settings. This is currently known as “Kasi”, and is being established across South and Southern Africa.

Inner City Network (Coming soon)

Disciple-Makers focused primarily on the extreme brokenness of the inner city work together to build Disciple-Making Movements amongst the neglected, marginalized and broken.

Business Leaders Network (Coming soon)

This is a new network we are incubating in 2023. Business leaders play an important role in multiplying Disciple-Making Movements in the workplace. This network will develop these leaders.

Legacy Church Network (Coming soon)

Legacy Churches form a vital part of movement in the city. They offer the structure and resources needed to help sustain movement in cities. Many of these traditional churches want to be more effective in Disciple-Making, as well as learn what it means to reach into brokenness and lostness with the Gospel.

Questions

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

What is a Disciple Making Movement?

Disciple Making Movements are defined by the rapid spread of the Gospel through ordinary people, and the multiplication of new disciples (Christ followers) that results in new faith communities.

How does Two Four Eight define "City?"

We use the term 'city' to describe high-density population environments. Urbanization is continuing at an incredible rate. In 2007, for the first time in world history, more humans lived in cities than in rural areas. By 2050, more than 70% of the world will live in cities.

What are Affinity Groups?

Affinity groups are large groups of people who have strong relational ties through some common factor such as locality, age, sport, culture, or art. We often refer to these simply as 'affinities.'

What is a Movement Champion?

A Movement Champion pioneers multiplying Disciple-making into a specific affinity or segment of a city. The Champion creates an environment of access by moving towards the brokenness in the affinity and equipping Disciple-makers to multiply disciples inside the affinity.

What is a Catalyst?

A City Catalyst is a leader whose specific focus is the entire city and who implements strategies to launch God Movements across the city. A City Catalyst builds a movement to reach the whole city, by raising up Champions for all the different affinities in the city.

What is an Affinity Network?

It's not uncommon to feel a stronger connection with people living in other cities than those in our own hometown. Affinity Networks facilitate meaningful connections between disciple-makers working in similar contexts around the world. Leaders can share and compare best practices specific to their unique contexts. These networks offer a space for like-minded individuals to learn and support each other's work.

What is the cost of the training?

There is no financial cost to the training. Donations are welcome and details can be found on the website. However, there is a time cost, a commitment cost, and a relational cost. Our Honor Agreement document outlines relational expectations that the team leader signs once teams enroll for the Pioneer Team Journey.

Am I expected to join something or leave my existing network of belonging?

We do not provide a network of primary belonging, but rather a shared learning experience and learning community. We encourage you to remain in any networks or denominations you belong to and to influence them towards movement thinking.
